Background – What is a CAP?

To provide our AP Party volunteers across the nation with campaign related projects that will directly drive various "planks" on The American Peasant Party's platform we have created *Citizen Action Programs* or CAP Projects.

Basic examples of CAP projects are Legalize Hemp Farming in America CAP 19, Change the National Voting Day CAP 2, and another would document the Electoral Recall procedures for US Senate and House of Representatives for all fifty (50) states – it just happens to be CAP 28.

Each CAP will take on a project life of its own working to address whatever the issue or issues fall under its heading. Some CAP projects will result in no legislation being enacted and/or revised while others could do quite a bit of both. This will be further explained in another Blog selection – About the Agenda and CAP Projects. There are currently 28 CAP Projects. The first 27 match up one-to-one with the 27 Proposals in An American Agenda that is the centerpiece of the book, *The Second Coming of Common Sense* (CS2).

Overall, the CAP designation is a way to permanently identify a particular issues or set-of related issues so that they may be tracked and progress reported back to the citizenry on a periodic basis on the Internet. Progress will be measured in values such as lives saved, assaults prevented, tax money saved and put to better uses, employment created, tax revenue source created, etc.
